

10 holiday ideas you probably haven't thought of



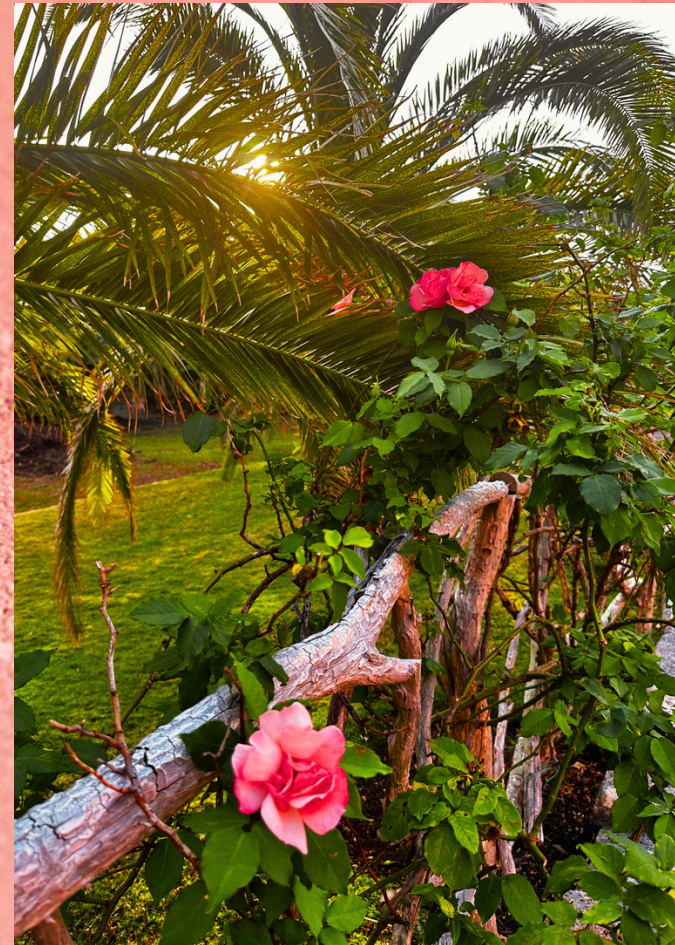
Travel can mean so many different things to different people. Indeed, even the same person might want adventure *and* a quiet retreat on the same holiday or two quite contrasting breaks during the year.

Known for its pink-sand beaches, historic architectural charm and azure waters, Bermuda is a unique Atlantic island escape. In five acres of subtropical private gardens, Ledgelets Cottage Colony is a stone's throw from Somerset Bridge and the natural beauty of Ely's Harbour, making it a perfectly positioned haven of peacefulness.

Originally opened in 1948, the accommodation is still owned and operated by the Young Family, and was recently completely refurbished with a mix of modern luxury and nostalgic chic. The pink poolside cottages have been updated with modern amenities that maintain their original style.



Relax in the heated pool and gather with friends or family at the clubhouse, wander the verdant estate and sample the Old Garden Rose Oil - made from rose species grown throughout the property.

Dine at your own pace (each cottage has its own kitchen and outdoor grill) and stroll down to the fishing dock. This is a place where you can wake up to the birds, drift off to sleep to a choir of tree frogs and sample the relaxed vibes of island life in between.
